

Notice to visa applicants

November 9, 2016

The Embassy of the United Republic of Tanzania in Tokyo would like to inform all visa applicants that from January 1, 2017, we will not accept any cash payment and therefore visa payments can only be made via bank transfer.

Upon receiving an application, the Embassy will contact denied cases only via phone or email within 24 hours. If an applicant is not contacted within 24 hours, they can proceed with the payment. The Embassy's bank account information is as follows.

On the fourth working day from the presentation of the visa application, the applicant can collect their visa upon presentation of proof of payment or deposit slip. The proof of the payment must have the following information;

- full name of the applicant
- amount of money deposited
- account number of the recipient
- entry date and reference number

\* All this information must be indicated on the printed receipt

\* Transfer fee must be borne by the applicant

Please note that due to this new procedure, it would take four (4) working days for the Embassy to issue a visa.
